Review of Registered Startups:

The Foundation has received a total of 13 startup applications for onboarding. These startups presented innovative ideas, business concepts, progress, and future plans during the meeting.

Each startup was reviewed by the committee members based on their presentation and potential. The committee then deliberated on which startups should be on boarded as pre-incubatees or incubatees into the SRIF.

- 13 Pravin Patil Zeromile Hyperlocal e-commerce platform targeting tier-2 and tier-3 cities for doorstep delivery of groceries, personal care, and electronics from neighborhood sellers.
Not recommended for onboarding.
- 14 Vedant Bhendakar Circuito Claro Solutions Pvt Ltd IoT-based toy. Selected as a pre-incubatee. After DPIIT onboarding as an incubatee.

Major Recommendations and Next Steps:

1. The selected startups are to be on boarded as pre-incubatees or incubatees based on the committee's evaluation.
2. Certain startups, especially those on boarded after DPIIT approval, are advised to obtain product certifications and testing reports to enhance credibility.
3. Some startups were advised to improve packaging and focus on market readiness aspects.
4. Zeromile e-commerce platform was not recommended for on boarding during this meeting.
5. The committee emphasized continued support and monitoring for the growth and success of onboarded startups.

Conclusion:

The meeting concluded with thanks from the Chairperson and members to all participants, especially to those startups presenting their innovative projects. The session ended with consensus on further on boarding actions and committee resolutions.
